SVQ Level 2 Apprenticeships Notice of Promulgation – 25th July 2016 (for apprentices who started before Monday 29 June 2015)

As a consequence of the forthcoming 2.5% increase in wages for Building Craft Operatives, the Scottish Building Apprenticeship and Training Council (SBATC) has agreed to recommend that the following wage rates should apply to Construction Specialist and Civil Engineering Apprentices undertaking an SVQ Level 2 apprenticeship whilst registered with SBATC from **Monday 25th July 2016**.

<u>Year</u>	<u>Hourly Rate of Pay (Advisory)</u>	<u>Weekly Rate of Pay (Advisory) (39 Hours)</u>
Year 2	£4.93	£192.27

NB: The second year rate of pay noted above will be subject to variation in accordance with the relevant National Minimum or Living Wage if the apprentice is aged 19 years or over.

The Scottish Building Apprenticeship and Training Council also recommend that the following hourly wage rates should apply to Experienced Construction Specialist and Civil Engineering Apprentices (aged 22 years of age or over when commencing their apprenticeship with previous industry experience) when undertaking an SVQ level 2 apprenticeship whilst registered with SBATC from **Monday 25th July 2016**.
